

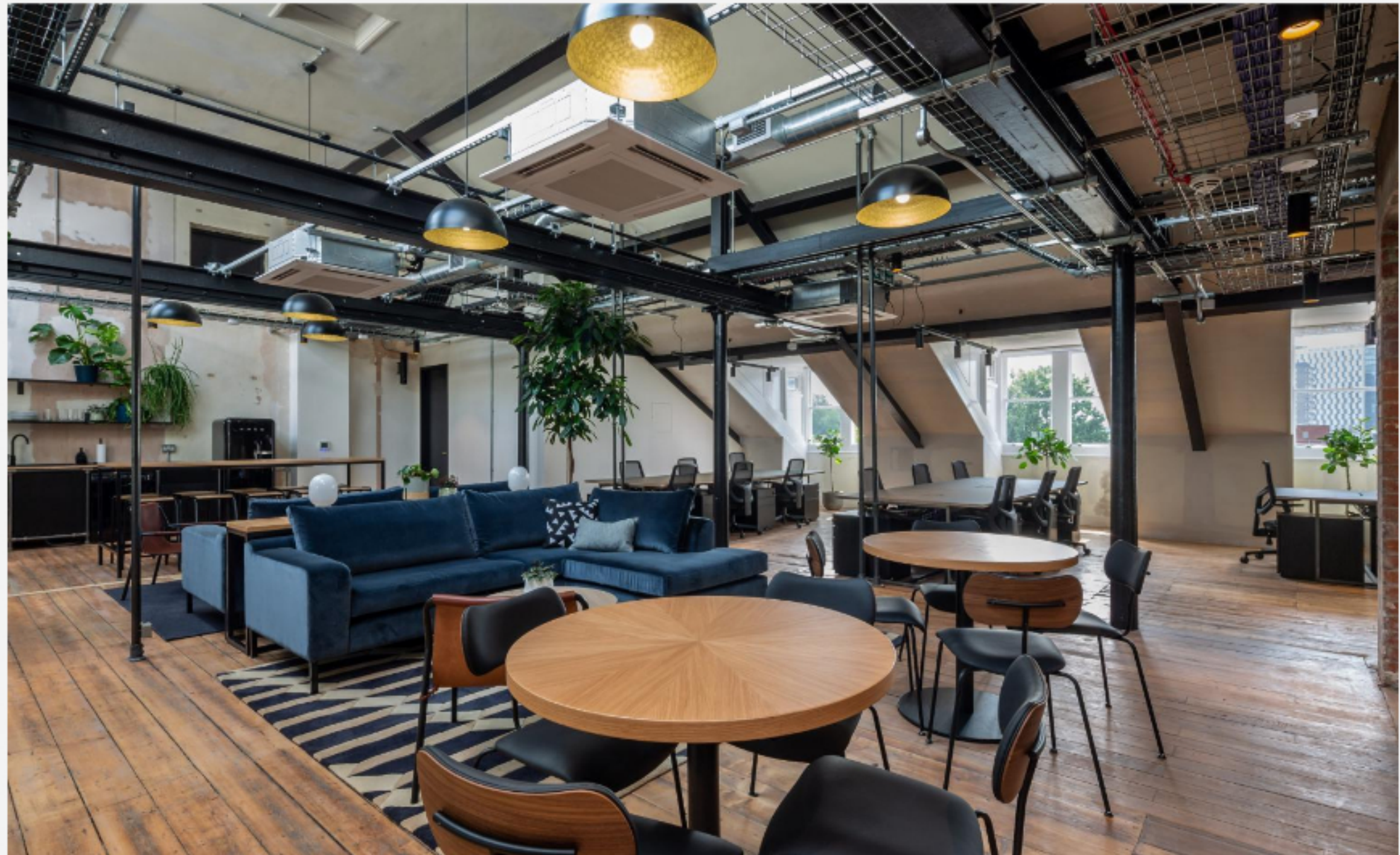
## The craftiest co-working spaces around the world

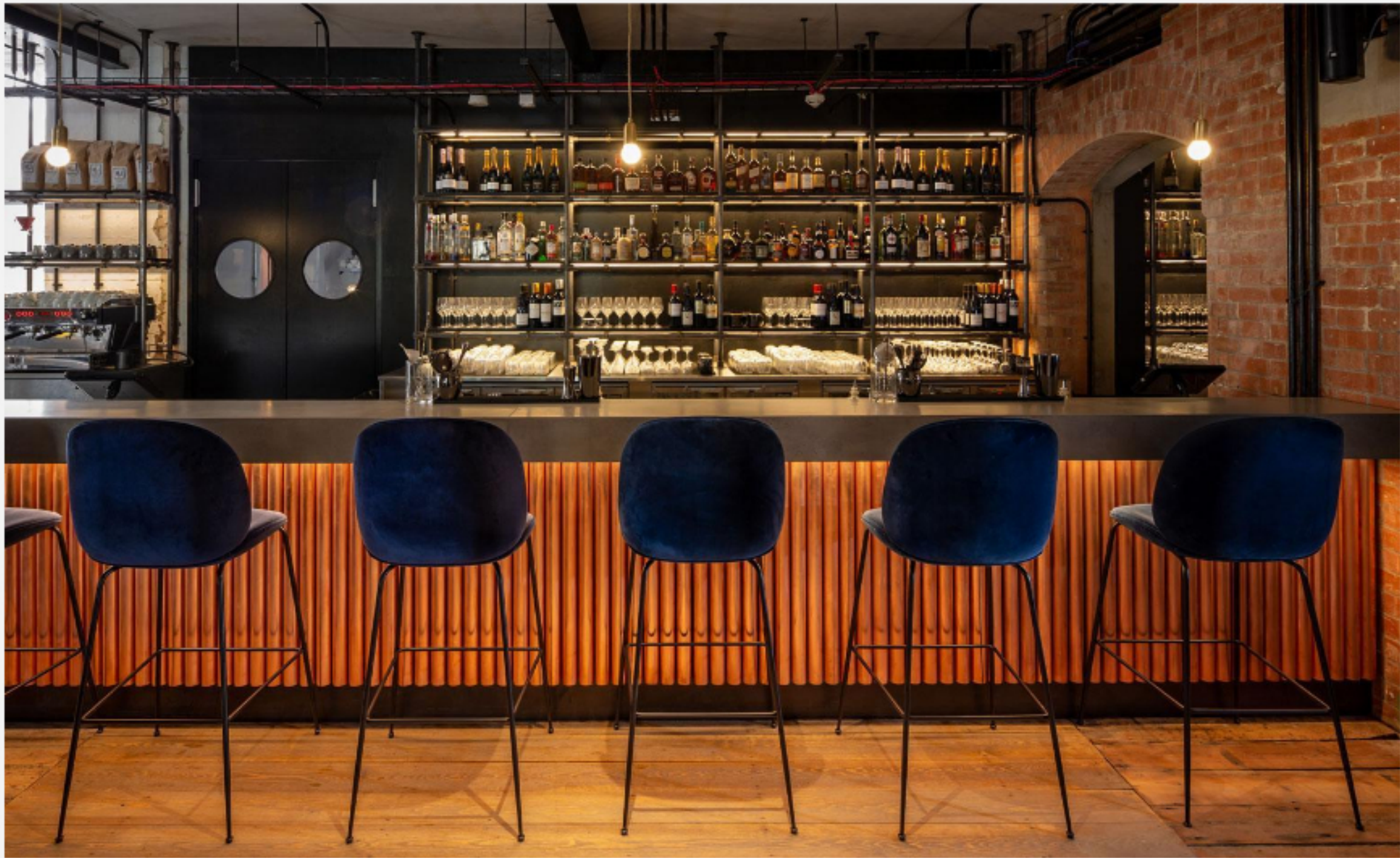
