

Squire & Partners launches Brixton Winter Windows with Landsdowne School

For the third year, Squire & Partners has launched its Winter Windows scheme, where it partners with local schools to create window displays. This year, The Department Store in Brixton will be lit-up with designs from the pupils of Landsdowne School, a special needs secondary school in Stockwell, London. After two workshops with the architects, the children created designs with coloured pipe cleaners. The resulting window displays, created with LED lights, feature reindeer antlers, fairy wings, microphones and a rainbow. The display will be up from December and through January, after being launched on 29 December by Lambeth deputy mayor, artist Philip Normal.
