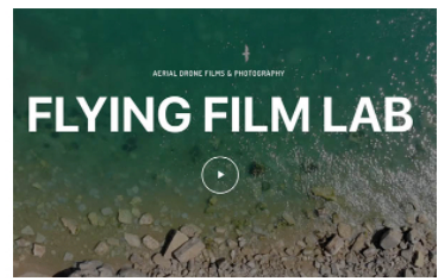
Stone Tapestry has been unveiled at [Surface Design Show 2022](#)

[Squire & Partners](#) was invited by Stone Federation for the second year running to design a bespoke installation for the show's Stone Gallery, which sits at the centre of the show.

In line with the show's theme of sustainability, this year Stone Tapestry focuses on the locality, application and reuse of natural stone, and showcases some of the impressive materials quarried in the UK – tapping into the ongoing conversation around using natural stone to deliver a more sustainable built environment.

Exhibition Stand for Stone Federation by Squire & Partners ©JamesBalston

The explorative piece created for the 2020 exhibit has been reused – with tables crafted by furniture maker Lema SpA and a tapestry of stones finished by high-end natural stone supplier SolidNature. A new array of stones has been added to this which explore different ways of reimagining and reusing the materials.

This year SolidNature has compiled and installed 14 distinctive stones from across the British Isles, supplied by Albion Stone, Burlington Stone, Ethical Stone Co. (in partnership with Britannicus Stone) and Haysom Purbeck Stone.

Stone samples are finished in different ways, from polished and sand-blasted to leathered and flamed – demonstrating the material's versatility, and reuse is explored by reimagining a single piece of stone carved into a number of different objects, giving it a secondary life.
