Kensington Palace grounds revamped by Squire & Partners

The 212,000 sq ft development in Kensington draws inspiration from the site's past, including the original and kitchen garden



Lancer Square combines contemporary low-rise living with access to wellness amenities, a garden and contemporary art installation, in close proximity to London's cultural landmarks.

The mixed-use scheme offers a collection of luxury residential, office and retail units designed to enliven the Kensington community. It comprises three blocks ranging from six to seven storeys, including two residential buildings and an office block. The retail and dining offering covers 14,000 sq ft spread amongst six ground floor and basement units.

The Squire & Partners team led the design process for the development's masterplan and the interiors scheme, which includes the residences, amenities, public spaces, garden and courtyard, retail and office space.
